



RETURN TO THE RINK-REMINDERS

MARCH 1, 2022

- All players/bench staff (participants) must upload their vaccination certificates on to our website.

To download your digital or print QR code, please visit covid-19.ontario.ca/get-proof. Individuals can also visit their local library or can call the Provincial Vaccine Contact Centre at 1-833-943-3900 to have their vaccine certificate mailed to them. You can also visit a Service Ontario centre to receive a printed copy.

- All AP players must be fully vaccinated to participate with the team they are AP'd to.
- Do not come to the facility if you are experiencing symptoms. If symptoms are noted you will be asked to leave.
- Active screening to enter is no longer required. Passive screening as you enter the arena is required. Please review the Health Screening questions posted at the entrances and if you answer NO to all the questions you may enter the facility. If you are sick, please stay at home, do not enter the arena.
- Capacity limits are back to 100% in a City Arena and Western Fair Sport Centre. As a result, teams may enter up to one hour before their ice rental. Groups are required to leave the dressing room no more than 20 minutes after their rental to allow for cleaning prior to the next group entering.
- Participants must be wearing a mask to enter the facility. Players can remove their masks prior to going on the ice. The mask must stay on in the dressing room. Bench Staff must always wear their masks.
- Spectators must wear a mask.
- Participants are to wash their hands with hand sanitizer upon entrance and exit.
- Players must bring their own labelled water bottle, no sharing of water bottles permitted.
- No Spitting or rinsing your mouth with water onto the ice or facility floor- this action will constitute immediate removal from ice/facility.
- Parents please do not congregate in the parking lot.
- For our younger players a maximum of 1 parent/guardian is allowed in the dressing room in the 15 mins prior to help your player with items such as skates. You must depart immediately following this task.
- If a player or coaching staff have symptoms or a positive covid test, or live with someone who has symptoms or a positive covid test, they must isolate for 5 days and be 24 hours free of symptoms if they have been fully vaccinated, and isolate for 10 days and be 24 hours free of symptoms if they are not fully vaccinated, before they can return to all activities with their team. The first day of symptoms or positive covid test, is day 0.
